There comes a time in everyone's life when simply knowing the names of a dozen post-1970 Arsenal goalkeepers simply isn't enough. Being able to reel off the complete cast of Dad's Army and the dates on which they died can begin to wear thin on even the most trivial of souls. This was the case for four young Sheffield lads desperately searching for a touch of excitement to brighten up their trivial, mundane and pitiful existence.

It seemed what was needed was direction, a vehicle for a kind of hero worship which was at best flattering, and at the worst downright born! At that very moment **THE MUZZLE CLUB** was

As soon as the small matter of who would play what was finalised, the lads set out to carve a reputation in their home town with a playlist which was to shatter the whole showbiz community, and in particular, Brookside Close.

Beginning with a character assassination on wartime radio clown Tommy Handley in "ITMA" and the teenage anthem "ANOREXIA", the group worked on their songs throughout the summer of '88 and went on to gain local airplay on BBC Radio Sheffield by December.

Then, in March of the following year after being inspired by a repeat showing of the classic "On The Buses" film, they played their first gig, and unlike Newport County they played regularly throughout the summer to enthusiastic local crowds.

After recording their first demo, "Bald Men Set The Pace" and dozens more celebrity deaths, more gigs followed featuring new songs about Ken Dodd, Eric Morcambe and Kevin Keegan. By the end of the year, their debut single had been recorded for release in 1990. This featured the songs "Slade" and "Actor"; one a tribute to the best band of the '70s (and glam rock idols of The Muzzle Club) and the other a tale about an aspiring young soap star.
